Corona Virus (Covid-19) Visitor Protocol

Following advice from the Government of Jersey and Public Health, Mont Nicolle School is mindful that we are required to take all reasonably practicable measures to protect our staff, pupils and the school community. As we continue to monitor the ever-changing information about Coronavirus (COVID-19), we respectfully request that all visitors adhere to the following procedures to help maintain a safe environment for Mont Nicolle School staff and pupils.

- To reduce the risk of Coronavirus entering the School Community, we are only permitting pre-booked visits to the School.
- Before entering Mont Nicolle School please ensure that you have washed your hands.
- **Upon entry to the school, masks/visors must be worn at all times.**
- On arrival all visitors will need to sanitise your hands using our electronic sanitiser. This must be done **before and after** using the iPad Passtab.
- Please sign in using our iPad Passtab system and collect your printed visitors' identification label, which must be worn throughout your visit and returned to your host when you leave.
- We request that you do not visit the School:

If you or any member of your household have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.

If you or any member of your household are showing any COVID19 symptoms as per the current Public Health guidance or if you are currently waiting for a test or test results for COVID-19.

If you have been contacted by a contact tracer and advised to self-isolate.

If you have entered Jersey from any country not listed as safe on the transit corridor list and are required to follow the current quarantine rules.

- All visitors must note the following:

You will be required to observe all of the guidelines on 2m social distancing, hand and respiratory hygiene measures, floor markings, displayed instructions and all other signage in place.

You must not enter any areas that you have not identified in your request to visit the school.
