My name is Paul Lees and I am a qualified F.A. coach who has worked in grassroots football in Jersey for the last ten years. As a qualified F.A. coach I undertake to:-

- Comply with the Laws of the Game, the rules of the Football Association and the rules of any competition in which they participate
