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ENGLISH

Text Drivers for this term are: What's in your pocket, Peg?, Letters from the Lighthouse, Poppy Field, Polar Bear and Survivors Part 1! All of our English lessons will be around these texts focusing on reading, writing, grammar, spoken language and spelling.

MATHS

The topics we will be covering this term in maths are:
Place value
The four operations
Fractions, decimals and percentages

SCIENCE

Year 6 are lucky enough to be taught by Mrs Brown for science this year. This term, she will be teaching the children about light and electricity through engaging and thought-provoking practical experiments.

PE

The first half term will be gymnastics and fitness, and the second half term will be dance and football.

COMPUTING

This term, we will be learning how to use Office 365. We will also be learning to create engaging PowerPoints and animations.

TOPIC

Our theme for this term is World War 2. Within geography, pupils will be learning about the human and physical elements that make up Europe. They will then look more closely at how Jersey was affected by the German Occupation in history after half-term.

RE

Year 6 will be challenged to think about the links between science and the Creation Story, and begin to seek answers about why some people choose to believe in God, and why others do not.

PSHE

Alongside PSHE lessons provided by the charity You Matter, pupils will learn about healthy and happy relationships.

FRENCH

This term we will be building on The French Experience that pupils were immersed in, in Year 5, by learning about the weather and travelling.
